Eligibility Criteria

You must meet the IGTO's eligibility requirements to apply for the 2022 graduate program:

- In accordance with the *Australian Public Service Act 1999* you must be an Australian Citizen at the time of application

- you must have finished at least a bachelor degree by 31 December 2021, with at least a credit average or higher; and
- your most recent degree must be no more than five years old on the date you lodge your application.
- on engagement, you are required to uphold the Australian Public Service (APS) Values and comply with the *APS Code of Conduct* as enshrined in the *Public Service Act 1999*.
- on engagement and in accordance with Section 22 (6) of the *Public Service Act 1999*, a security clearance is a condition of employment for employees of the IGTO.

If your only qualification is from an overseas institution, you will be required to provide Australian documentation recognising your qualification(s).

- 15 March 2021 – Australian Government Graduate Program (AGCP) careers fair
- 30 April 2021 – applications for the IGTO 2022 Graduate Program close
- June 2021 – Virtual interviews occur
- Offers from 1 July 2021
